

Muslim Women's Leadership Initiative

Leadership Victoria and the Islamic Council of Victoria are proud to offer a scholarship for the 2022 Williamson Leadership Program.

To be eligible for a scholarship, an applicant must:

- be of the Muslim faith
- identify as a woman
- be an established or high potential leader with a proven career
- demonstrate how your Williamson experience will shape your community participation, with reference to furthering your participation within the Muslim community.

Williamson fees are structured so that there is an organisational and an individual component. The standard organisational component will be covered by the LV-ICV scholarship. The successful applicant will be liable for the individual financial contribution and the difference between Williamson Standard and Williamson Intensive/Intensive Plus if one of those options is selected.

Selected candidates will be expected to participate in a range of communications activities connected to the Islamic Council of Victoria and Leadership Victoria including, but not limited to:

- Newsletter and magazine articles
- Social media posts
- Website stories
- Other opportunities related to the Islamic Council of Victoria.

Additionally, they are required to contribute to scholarship progress reporting.

Scholarships are not transferable.

The successful applicant will be asked to commit to full attendance and participation in 2022 Williamson. Applicants should carefully consider the time commitment before applying – the successful applicant who finds they are unable to meet the requirements must forgo the scholarship.
