



Leadership Victoria Foundation scholarships

Scholarships or part-scholarships can sometimes become available during the application period.

To be eligible for a Leadership Victoria Foundation Scholarship you must be:

- able to demonstrate financial need
- an established or high potential leader
- able to demonstrate how your participation will shape their community participation

In addition, you must meet at least one of the following eligibility criteria:

- living with a disability
- member of a Victorian culturally and linguistically diverse community
- identify as Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander
- applicants personal or work efforts are focussed on supporting individuals and communities experiencing disadvantage

Williamson fees are structured so that there is an organisational and an individual component. The LVF scholarship will contribute a portion of the organisational component and the successful applicants will be expected to contribute the individual component. It will only be in extremely rare circumstances that a full (100%) scholarship will be provided.

Selected candidates will be expected to participate in a range of communications activities connected with this scholarship including, but not limited to:

- newsletter and magazine articles
- social media posts
- website stories
- potential media opportunities.

Additionally, they are required to contribute to scholarship progress reporting.

Scholarships are not transferable.

The successful applicant will be asked to commit to full attendance and participation in the program. Applicants should carefully consider the time commitment before applying – a successful applicant who finds they are unable to meet the requirements must forgo the scholarship.
