



Scholarship Opportunity for people with a disability

Thanks to the support of the Victorian Government's Office for Disability, a full scholarship opportunity exists for the 2023 Williamson Community Leadership Program.

To be eligible for a scholarship, an applicant must:

- Identify as a person living with a disability
- be an established or high potential leader with a proven career
- demonstrate how your Williamson experience will shape your community participation

Williamson fees are structured so that there is an organisational and an individual component. This scholarship will cover the cost of both the organisational and individual component for the Williamson Base Package.

The successful candidate may be expected to participate in a range of communications activities connected to the Office for Disability and Leadership Victoria including for example, but not limited to:

- Newsletter and magazine articles
- Social media posts
- Website stories
- Other opportunities related to the Office for Disability.

Additionally, they are required to contribute to scholarship progress reporting.

Scholarships are not transferable.

The successful applicant will be asked to commit to full attendance and participation in the 2023 Williamson Community Leadership Program. Applicants should carefully consider the time commitment before applying – the successful applicant who finds they are unable to meet the requirements must forgo the scholarship.
