



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1. What is the Future Impact Community Leadership Program?

The **Future Impact Community (FIC)** leadership program brings together local leaders from business, community, and government to strengthen their leadership, connect them across sectors, and deepen their impact.

In this transformative, five-day experience delivered by **Leadership Victoria**, you'll build meaningful relationships, grow your leadership capabilities, and gain the tools to lead through complexity alongside others who share your commitment to community.

Whether you're tackling tough challenges, seeking new ways to collaborate, or wanting to grow as a leader, **FIC equips you to lead change - now and into the future.**



What you'll gain:

- A powerful network of local leaders across sectors, backgrounds, and locations to collaborate with and grow alongside long after the program ends
- Practical leadership tools and strategies you can apply immediately to your work and community
- Foundational understanding of Adaptive Leadership, a proven framework to help you navigate change and mobilise others
- Real-world experience and feedback, working on a community-based challenge that matters to you
- Inspiring leadership case studies and deep conversations with experienced leaders who've led through complexity and who are open to your questions

This program will challenge, stretch, and support you as you grow into the leader your community needs - for today and tomorrow.


2. Learning Framework & Program outline

Drawing on Leadership Victoria's 35-year experience developing purpose-driven leaders, participants will engage via the following learning framework:





Program Outline



• Day 1 - Leadership Insight

Start by getting to know yourself as a leader. You'll explore your strengths, values, and what matters most to you, in a safe and supportive group environment. By the end of the day, you'll have the beginnings of your own leadership story and a clear sense of the leader you want to become.

• Day 2 - Adaptive Toolkit

Learn practical tools and frameworks for leading through uncertainty and change. You'll work on real examples and explore different ways to approach challenges, while gaining confidence in handling complexity. You'll leave with your own "adaptive challenge" to work on during the program.

• Day 3 - Future Impact

Dive into how to create lasting change through collective action. Working in small groups, you'll explore how to engage people, bring diverse voices to the table, and design a project that matters to your community. You'll leave with the first outline of your own Impact Project.

Day 4 – Collective Purpose

Discover how to share your skills, experience, and ideas in ways that inspire others to connect with you. You'll create your own elevator pitch, learn how to grow a purposeful network, and understand how to build relationships that open doors and create impact.

• Day 5 - Leverage Opportunities

Put everything together as you pitch your community impact project. You'll develop your skills in public speaking, storytelling, and persuasion, while getting high-quality feedback from guest experts. This is a day to celebrate your progress, share your vision, and commit to what comes next.

Post-Program Webinar – Keep the Momentum

Reconnect with your group, share updates, and get fresh inspiration from a guest speaker on sustaining momentum in your leadership journey. This online session helps you stay connected, supported, and focused on turning your ideas into reality.

3. Who can apply for the program?

Applicants must be emerging or established leaders who:

- Live and/or work in the City of Greater Dandenong or City of Casey local government areas (LGAs)
- Work in the business, government or community sectors
- Want to strengthen their leadership capabilities
- Want to be part of a new, purpose-driven peer group
- Are currently, or are interested in, being part of driving a community impact project
- Have 1+ years of experience in leadership or management (including in community, sport or volunteer roles)
- Able to confirm their availability for the duration of the program.

Leadership Victoria welcomes and encourages applications from leaders of all abilities, sexualities, cultural and linguistic backgrounds, and ages.



4. Who can't apply?

The following individuals cannot apply for the Program:

 Any person residing outside of the City of Casey and City of Greater Dandenong Local Government Areas

5. What will be funded?

All five (5) in-person FIC program days, inclusive of all program materials, access to an online Learning Management System and catering (morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea) on each program day.

Series 1 of the program will be hosted in the City of Greater Dandenong Local Government Area at venues to be advised. This program has been generously funded as part of the 'Citizen Leadership for Resilient Victorian Communities' project by the Helen Macpherson Smith Trust.

6. How will my application be assessed?

Applications will be assessed focusing on your leadership experience to date, your current role, any involvement you have had in community, and the contribution you can make to the diversity of the cohort.

You will be asked to complete the following questions in your application. You must complete your application in one sitting, so please have this information ready to submit.

- Your personal and contact information
- Current employment/key life roles
- To upload your resume, no more than 4 pages long, outlining employment and volunteer roles (PDF, DOC, DOCX, PNG, JPG, JPEG and GIF files no larger than 16MB accepted)

Written responses:

- What are you most proud of achieving in your career to date? 100 word limit
- What are your three key priorities in your current role? 100 word limit
- What are you most proud of achieving in your community to date? 100 word limit
- What is an issue for your community and/or society that matters to you, and why? 100 word limit
- How active are you on addressing that issue? What barriers prevent you and/or others from acting? 100 word limit
- Why are you applying for this program, and why now? What do you hope to gain? 100 word limit
- What leadership strengths, personal attributes, professional and life experiences do you bring that would add to this program? 100 word limit
- How do you think this program will contribute to your impact in your community? 100 word limit
- You must also confirm your availability for the duration of the Program in the application form (please see 'Key Dates' at Item 10 in this document)
- At least 1 referee, who may be contacted during review of your application and/or during the interview process

7. What is the application and notification process?

Applications are submitted online using the online application form. Applications will open at **9.00am on Wednesday 20 August 2025.**
